This man's name is Dietrich Bonhoeffer, one of several German preachers who dared to speak out against Adolph Hitler. On GRACE and COSTLY GRACE. Cheap grace is wanting to be a Christian without wanting to change any of our ways of living. It is forgiveness without repentance. That of course, is not the kind of grace that the Bible talks about. God's grace is COSTLY because it calls us to follow, and it is grace because it calls us to follow Jesus Christ. It is costly because it cost a man his life; it is costly because it condemns sin and grace because it justifies the sinner. Read Romans 5:6-8; 8-32.
