### THE CHALLENGE OF CONGREGATIONAL GROWTH

**God wants His church--this church--to grow!** This is obvious from the Great Commission which makes it mandatory to make disciples of all nations. (Matt. 28:19) The early church, the model church, was a growing church. Some 3,000 obeyed the gospel on Pentecost. We read of the addition of about 5,000 in Acts 4:4, then in Acts 5:14 we are told that multitudes both men and women became believers and were added to the Lord. Acts 6:7

Living organisms grow. It is grow or die. And the Lord's church is a living organism. (Eph. 1:22,23) You can put a wood fence post in the ground and it will immediately rot. You can plant a tree in the ground and it will immediately grow. The key to the growth of this congregation and all others is found in Eph. 4:15,16.
