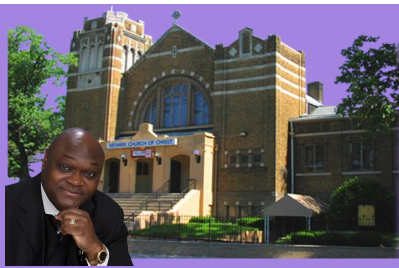

This is our theme song, the second phase of the Marching Orders of the Great Commission, our declaration against apathy, and an inoculation against the dreadful disease of intoxication with past successes. **Complacency is a great enemy in life.** It takes work to succeed in life and it takes works to remain successful.

This theme demands **PUTTING FIRST THINGS FIRST.** Jesus should not be an after-thought but the first thought in our lives. (Matt. 6:33) I hear Jesus saying, Go into my vineyard and work, and what ever is right, I'll pay. (Matthew 20:4) Paul thunders, "Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
