
# PRIORITIES—FIXED OR MIXED?

A person afoot in the desert, hot and thirsty wants water above everything else. Someone suffering excruciating pain wants relief from that pain more than anything else. A starving person longs for food. All these situations set up clear priorities and their solutions are obvious. If man were no more than a beast, his priorities would always be obtaining those things that would meet his physical and material needs alone. But the basic priority of man, who was created in God's image, is a right relationship to God. Until he fins this out, man spends his time and energies on things and is left with the hangover of emptiness and utter frustration.

Even the born-again child of God can allow his priorities to become so mixed up that he lacks the peace of mind that God wants him to have. A man's priorities are fixed by his perspectives. The psalmist was confused and discouraged when he saw the evident prosperity of the wicked, UNTIL I WENT INTO THE SANCTUARY OF GOD, UNDERSTOOD I THEIR END. (Psalm 73:17) And then he leaps out with this triumphant conclusion: "THOU SHALT GUIDE ME WITH THEY COUNSEL, AND AFTERWARD RECEIVE ME TO GLORY. WHOM HAVE I IN HEAVEN BUT THEE? AND THERE IS NONE UPON EARTH THAT I DESIRE BESIDE THEE. MY FLASH AND MY HEART FAILETH: BUT GOD IS THE STRENGTH OF MY HEART, AND MY PORTIONFOREVER." (Psalm 73:24-26) Let a man gain the right perspectives on life, on himself and on his God, and his priorities will fall in place. Until that happens he cannot know the peace of God that transcends man's comprehension.

Un-regenerated man has his priorities mixed up. The physically blind are without the ability to discern the distance between objects. The spiritually blind cannot see themselves correctly in relation to God and life. Un-regenerated man has rejected his creation and has become his own god: consequently. he has lost his perspectives, and mixed up his priorities. No wonder our world is perpetual chaos. Paul said, "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them." (2 Cor. 4:3,4) Unsaved men put transitory things before eternal things, pleasure before moral principles, their own ideas and feelings before God's emancipating truth, time for himself above time for God, and the material before the spiritu-
