

THE CHALLENGE OF CONGREGATIONAL GROWTH

God wants His church--this church--to grow! This is obvious from the Great Commission which makes it mandatory to make disciples of all nations. (Matt. 28:19) The early church, the model church, was a growing church. Some 3,000 obeyed the gospel on Pentecost. We read of the addition of about 5,000 in Acts 4:4, then in Acts 5:14 we are told that multitudes both men and women became believers and were added to the Lord. Acts 6:7

Living organisms grow. It is grow or die. And the Lord's church is a living organism. (Eph. 1:22,23) You can put a wood fence post in the ground and it will immediately rot. That body is to be together, joined together, fitly joined together. That body is to be compacted by that which every joint supplies.
